


### THE MASTER SPEAKS

The atmosphere changed its course in San Diego on July 23, 2023, as the hot blazing sun gave way to divine showers with cool breeze and serenity spreading all around. Amidst such a peaceful backdrop, CMSD families and guests were eagerly awaiting the arrival of their *Guru*, Swami Swaroopananda, the global head of Chinmaya Mission.

Lakshmi Aunty, Sukumar Uncle and the CMSD board members along with Brni. Akalka welcomed Swamiji at the car and escorted him to the entrance.

#### Welcome and Inauguration



The rhythmic drum beats reminding everyone of Śiva's ḍamaru and CMSD Chinmaya senā reverentially welcoming Swamiji with "Tvam hi no netā" composition by Pujya Guruji was indeed an apt reception, as it paid obeisance to our entire Guru Paramparā! Swamiji lovingly whispered, "This is the best reception I have ever received". What a blessing from the Guru himself!



Swamiji was accorded a Purnakumbha welcome after which he offered his prayers to Jyoti Vināyakā in Praṇava Nilayam. CMSD president Sukumar Uncle and chief sevak Lakshmi delivered Aunty enthusiastic welcome address recalling Swamiji's brief visit to the Chinmaya Jyoti āśrama five years ago during the 25th Chinmaya Mahasamadhi and camp welcomed him for his first Jñāna Yajña in Chinmaya Jyoti.





The meditative "Śiva namanam" was presented elegantly by CMSD children. This was followed by a Hindi play depicting sincere devotion of Pārvati towards Śiva. Even when saptaṛṣi-s playfully mocked the virtues of Śiva or questioned Pārvati's intellect, she was unfazed. She matched saptaṛṣi-s' wit in expressing her unswerving devotion to Lord Śiva. It was a fitting beginning to the Jñāna Yajña as Swamiji unlocked the secrets of Śiva-Pañcākṣara-Stotram.

#### Jñāna Yajña on Śiva-Pañcākṣara-Stotram, July 23 through July 27, 2023







**CMSD Swaranjali** rendered a beautiful *bhajan* "*Guru brahma rupa jāno*, *Śiva kā svarupa māno*" as Swamiji ascended to the podium.

Swamiji's book on the Śiva-Pañcākṣara-Stotram was officially released in the āśrama prior to the start of the Jñāna Yajña and the first copy of his book was presented to Lakshmi Aunty.

What an auspicious week at Chinmaya Jyoti with Swami Swaroopananda's unfoldment of the Śiva-Pañcākṣara-Stotram. Each evening Swamiji successively unfolded the five verses of the sacred mantra "Om Namaḥ Śivāya" revealing the correlation between the symbolism and vedantic essence depicted by the embodiment of compassion - Śiva.

Along with humor, engaging stories about Gurudev, and practical insights on *dharma*, relationships, and old age, the audience was moved by Swamiji's special emphasis on the need for our hearts to bloom with love for the higher to overcome the five main worldly fears we deal with as humans.

Swamiji also inspired us when he shared that this whole creation, including ourselves, comes about from a *yajña*, or sacrifice. Sacrifice is only possible where there is love. Love knows only to give of itself, whereas compromise contains selfishness.

During the week, fresh Bilva plant brought by Kelkar family was anointed by Pujya Swamiji himself. A perfect offering for Lord *Śiva*!



Each evening after the lecture, Swamiji met with CMSD members - some seeking his blessings, some wanting to share their joy of learning from the discourse and some wanting to offer *praṇām-s*. And to all, Swamiji's gestures showed his warmth and affection. One such joyous moment captured above shows Swamiji cheerfully singing along "*Janmadinamidam*" to celebrate the birthday of **Eshan Patibandla**. What a blessing!





A special video presentation showcasing the *bhūmi pūjā* and inauguration of the beautiful  $\bar{a}\acute{s}rama$  rekindled memories in all the hearts.

The message from Pujya Swami Swaroopananda for this auspicious day through a poem composition "Look Within" was fitting for this "sādhanā day".









As is the tradition at CMSD, the āśrama wore a festive look as all members came dressed in traditional Kerala outfits. After chanting of *Guru stotram*, the *Chinmaya Jyoti* lamp was lit by Lakshmi Aunty at 5:45 PM, which is the exact time of our beloved Pujya Gurudev's *Mahāsamādhi* in San Diego 30 years ago.




### <u>Śrī Kṛṣṇa Janmāṣṭami</u>
